Questions and Answers Regarding National Standards for Organic Agriculture

Does the crop in a buffer zone need to be visually distinguishable from the organic crop? Can birds hatched from eggs treated with antibiotics be certified organic? Can chlorine be used to disinfect poultry carcasses?

The Standards Interpretation Committee submits new questions & answers to public consultation. These new interpretations are based on the revised Canadian Organic Standards published November 25 2015.

Please note that the consultation period is reduced to 30 days in order to speed up the processing of questions submitted by the sector.
